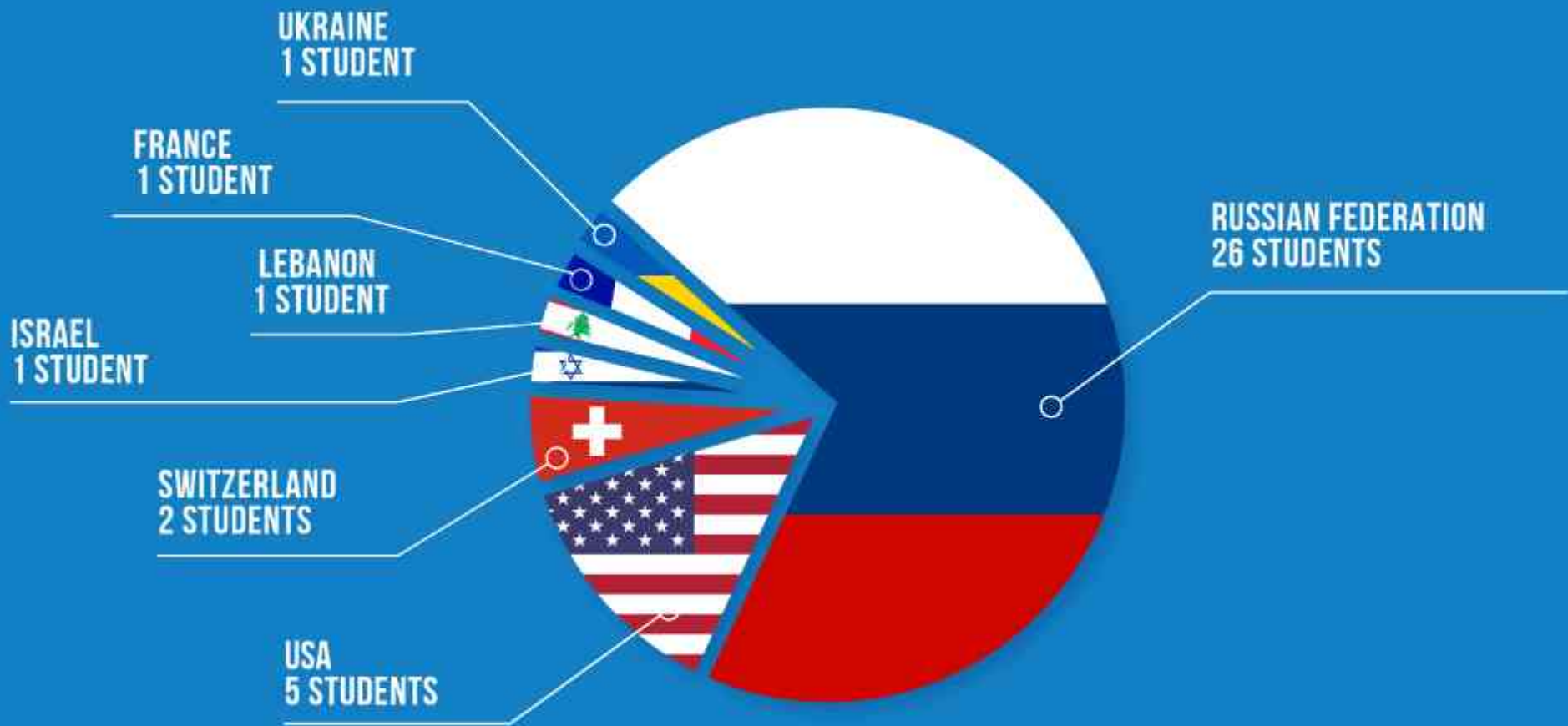

STAFF RETRAINING

- In the academic year of 2019-2020, the teachers of Educational-Sport Complex underwent a series of training courses.

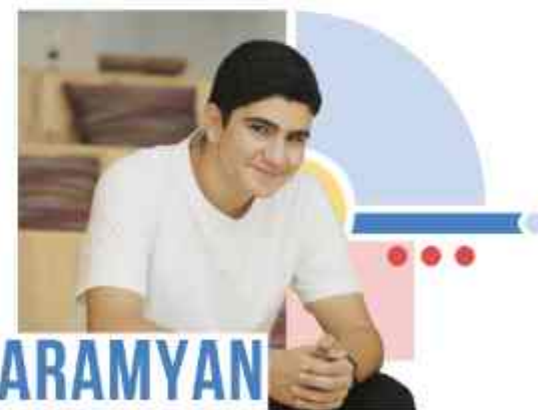

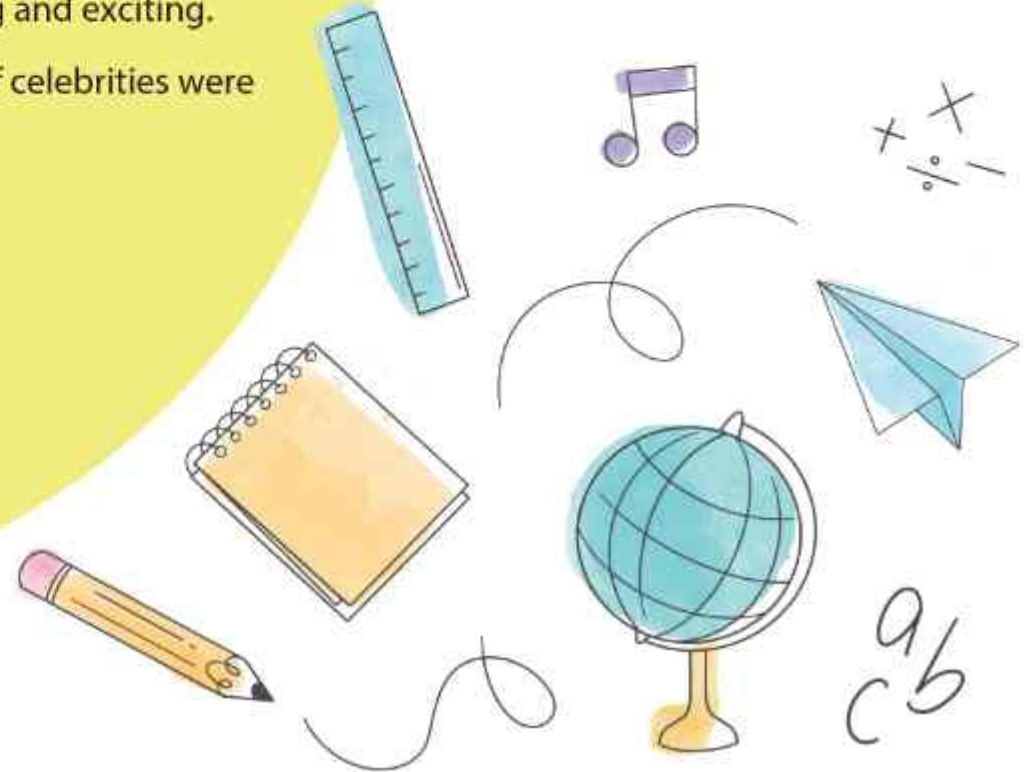

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS



The past academic year was eventful for students, teachers, and the ESC administration staff. Despite all the challenges associated with the start of the school, teachers and administration staff have made every effort to make learning at the school interesting and exciting. During the year, several events and meetings with the participation of celebrities were held, during which the students were active participants.



On September 1 the Day of Knowledge, a major event was held dedicated to the official opening of the school of Educational-Sport Complex of "Gazprom Armenia" CJSC.



On September 21 the Dean of the Faculty of History of YSU, Doctor of Historical Sciences, Professor Edic Minasyan held an open lesson for the students of the educational-sport complex, dedicated to RA Independence Day.

He hoped that such historic events will become a good tradition in the newly opened school and will strengthen the national identity.



Elementary school students also joined the celebration organizing thematic chalk drawing in the courtyard.



On October 25, within the framework of the days of Chinese culture, the Educational-Sport Complex hosted foreign students from the Dilijan International School. They met with students studying Chinese and introduced them to Chinese culture.



In November 2019, the students of our school: Natalie Aksyan (1st grade), Gevorg Gyulkhasyan, and Rafael Movsesyan

(3rd grade) took part in Mental Arithmetic International Competition in Sochi. Natalie took the first place, Gevorg took the second place, and Rafael earned the title of "Super Champion".



On November 19,

Hovhannes Davtyan, one of our coaches of Sport and Health Center, won the World Cup in Mas-wrestling competition held among 29 national teams.



On November 28, an event dedicated to the 150th anniversary of Komitas was held at the school of the Educational-sport complex. The event was preceded by an excursion to the Komitas Museum-Institute.



On December 18, the Olympic champion, three-time World Champion and five-time European Champion, UNICEF National Ambassador Arthur Aleksanyan and his father, who is Artur's coach, were hosted at Gazprom Armenia CJCS's Educational-Sport Complex. During the meeting, they answered many questions posed by the students.



He shared his formula of success with the students, which is: diligence, aspiration, and responsibility.



On December 20, a splendid concert-event was organized on the occasion of New Year and Christmas. During the event, students presented several musical and dance performances. After the event, the students' parents and employees of the Educational complex participated in a charity exhibition sale where the students of the school presented their handmade items - paintings, holiday decorations made of ceramics, and other materials.



All proceeds from the sale, 1,040,000 AMD, were transferred to the secondary school after A. Udumyan of the border village of Choratan, Tavush region.



On December 27, on New Year's Eve, a festive event was organized at the ice rink of our complex, during which students of the ESC school and students attending our figure skating section performed.



On January 16, European Men's Figure Skating Championships were held in Graz, Austria where our coach Slavik Hayrapetyan representing Armenia ranked 18th in total of short and free skating in the competition of 35 participants from 26 countries. Overcoming the initial stage, with 66.89 scores he entered the final among the first 24 skaters.



January 28,

a festive concert was organized in our educational complex on the occasion of the 28th anniversary of the formation of the Armenian Army. Major General Arkady Ter-Tadevosyan, also known as Komandos, the hero of the Artsakh liberation war was a special guest.

During the event, students asked many questions and received answers from Komandos himself.

The living hero of our time shared his remarkable life stories with those present and told about the famous "Wedding in the Mountains" operation, comrades-in-arms, the hardships of war, and the joy of victory.



At the end of the meeting, students presented Komandos's portrait – painted with their hands.

The meeting was a living lesson for all of us and a call to keep what has been achieved at the cost of living.



February 13,

In the educational complex the religious holiday of Tyarnendaraj was celebrated, in which everyone took part: the students, the teachers, and the employees of the complex. According to the concept of the day, a bonfire was lit in the schoolyard - accompanied by national songs and dances.



February 18,

At the lesson on the topic "Myths of Ancient Armenia", the 6th graders of our school introduced ancient Armenian gods of mythology which was an effective way to learn about Armenian mythology. Parents attending the lesson said they highly appreciate the efforts of the teacher Arsen Vardanyan and his dedication to work. They noticed positive changes in children's interests, love of reading, and the subject.



February 19, the birthday of all Armenian poet Hovhannes Tumanyan is celebrated in Armenia as a Book Donation Day to increase interest and love towards reading. On the occasion of the holiday, the students of our educational complex prepared a series of beautiful events, during which they told about the origins of the book, presented Tumanyan's creative path and his public activities.

The play "Death of Kikos" was staged, the role of a book and reading was discussed, reflecting the fact that being a literate and versatile person is the guarantee of a strong state and a literate society. At the end of the holiday, according to the tradition, the students gifted each other books.



On February 21,

the Day of the Mother Tongue a quiz-class for 5th graders was organized. During the lesson, students presented many proverbs and sayings, recited poems dedicated to their native language, and told about the history of the Armenian language. Then the members of the group winning the quiz were awarded with diplomas.

Aiming at preserving the purity of our native language and spread the culture of beautiful speech, the students who spoke their native language more beautifully and more literately received diplomas too.



Since March 17, due to the emergency in the entire territory of the Republic of Armenia, our educational complex has also switched to distance learning.



May 9 is a Triple Holiday for Armenians: the victory of the Great Patriotic War, the Liberation of Shushi, and the anniversary of the Artsakh Defense Army's establishment.
